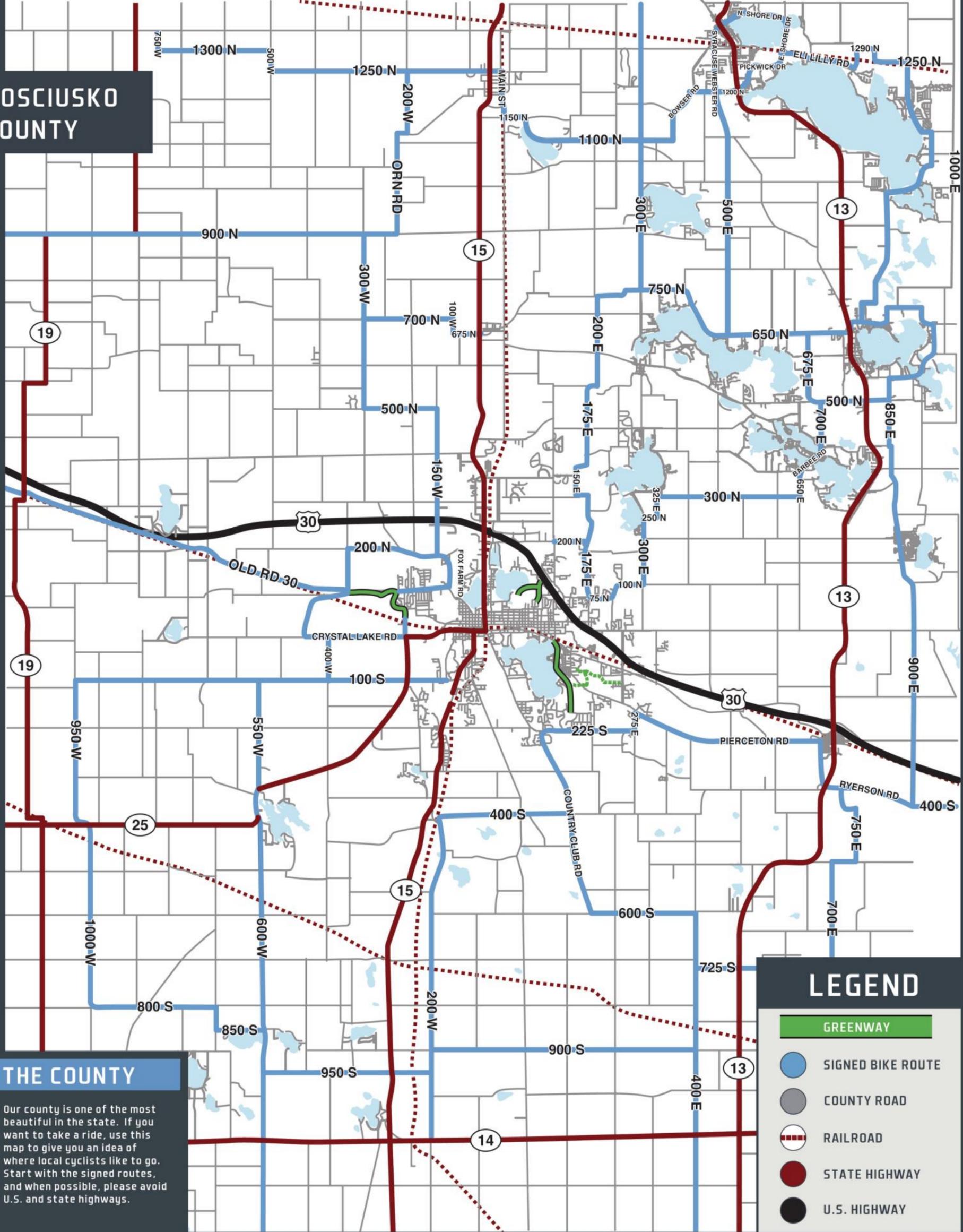


# KOSCIUSKO COUNTY

## THE COUNTY

Our county is one of the most beautiful in the state. If you want to take a ride, use this map to give you an idea of where local cyclists like to go. Start with the signed routes, and when possible, please avoid U.S. and state highways.

## RULES OF THE ROAD

Know the tips: these are some biking habits of successfully safe cyclists.

### WEAR A HELMET

Protect your brain. It's easy, but can make all the difference.

### DON'T RIDE DISTRACTED

You are vulnerable. Make sure you are aware of your surroundings.

### LOOK, SIGNAL, LOOK AGAIN

Just like a car, you must signal your turns. You can use the method that is best for you.



Don't weave in and out of traffic or parked cars. The more predictably you ride, the safer you are.

#### ACT LIKE A CAR



It's the law because it's safe. Nearly one in four crashes involve cyclists riding the wrong way.

#### RIDE WITH TRAFFIC



Make eye contact with drivers to make sure they see you. Always use a headlight and a rear reflector when it's dark.

#### STAY VISIBLE



EITHER **1** signal and turn left from the left lane like a car. OR **2** ride straight to the far-side crosswalk and dismount. Then walk your bike across the street while inside the crosswalk. (see illustration above)

#### TURN LEFT THE RIGHT (CORRECT) WAY



The law indicates that people on foot have the right-of-way on sidewalks. Walk your bike in a crowd, and stop to look before crossing streets and driveways.
